- 3. Hall discussions, "Bimeza" are strictly forbidden.
- 4. Campaigning hours shall start from 7:00 am to 9:00 pm in accordance with the Makerere Guild Constitution Article 71(a).
- Affiliation with any political party by any aspirant is strictly forbidden in accordance with Section 6(2) of the Makerere University Students' Guild Statute.
- 6. Instigating any form of violence is strictly forbidden in accordance with Article 71(e) the Makerere University Students' Guild Constitution and Section 6(2) of the Makerere University Students' Guild Statute
- 7. Defacing the University buildings and littering the compound/roads with campaigning materials is strictly forbidden in accordance with Article 71(c) and (d) of the Makerere University Students' Guild Constitution.
- 8. Making noise and campaigning outside the stipulated campaigning time is strictly forbidden in accordance with Article 71(f) of the Makerere University Students' Guild Constitution.
