
How to Access and Download Your Change of Programme Letter


Step 1: Log into Your Student Portal

Begin by logging into your student portal. You can do this by visiting the following link: https://myportal.mak.ac.ug. Make sure you have your login credentials ready.




Step 2: Locate Services on the Left Pane

Under the "Services" menu, select the "Service History" option. This will open a new window with important notifications.




Submit it to Senate for Final Approval."
