



CONFIGURE MOZILLA TO UPDATE AUTOMATICALLY

1. Log on to the computer on which the configuration is to be made.
2. Double-click the Mozilla Firefox icon to initialize the web browser.
3. Once opened, click the **Firefox** button at the top left corner of the window.
4. From the displayed menu, go to the **Options > Options** option.



1. On the opened **Options** box, click to select the **Advanced** icon from the displayed icon bar.
2. Once on the **advanced** interface, click the **Update** tab.
3. Under the **Firefox updates** section, click to select the **Automatically install updates (recommended, improved security)** radio button.



1. Once done, click **OK** button to save the changes.
2. Restart Mozilla Firefox to allow the changes to take effect.
